TO BE COMPLETED IN CASES OF RETROACTIVE VALIDATION	
<i>Convalidation is regarded as an actual marriage and implies that the couple was not married beforehand. It will often be better to seek a retroactive validation or sanatio which recognises the invalid marriage as having been valid. In this case, no ceremony of renewal of consent is required, though the pastor may celebrate an appropriate liturgy with them. The Pre-Marriage Inquiry Form is to be filled out as fully as possible.</i>
